

The Friends foster a positive relationship between the Library and the community, secure volunteers, and raise funds to support the Library System. Library Advisory Board

The Chambers County Library Advisory Board is a group of 7 citizens from the county, appointed by Commissioners' Court. Terms for the board members are for two years, with three full terms allowed per member.

Advisory Board considerations involve all public policies used by the Library System. These include the library mission statement, fees and fines, loan periods, and long-range planning. Board members serve as contact persons for community residents who might have interests and concerns about the library system.

The Advisory Board does not act as an administrative group; the County Librarian is the executive officer for the Library System, and the Advisory Board provides direction through policy decisions and advice offered.


